Prevention and conduct

The following information applies for the uses indicated in subsection 1.2 of the Safety Data Sheet. If available, please refer to the product information sheet for application and handling instructions. Normal use conditions are assumed for this section.

Recommended safety measures for handling the undiluted product:

Appropriate engineering controls: Provide a good standard of general ventilation.

Avoid direct contact and/or splashes where possible. Train personnel. Appropriate organisational controls:

Personal protective equipment Eye / face protection: Safety glasses are not normally required. However, their use is recommended in those cases where

splashes may occur when handling the product.

Hand protection: Rinse and dry hands after use. For prolonged contact protection for the skin may be necessary.

No special requirements under normal use conditions. **Body protection:**

should be avoided.

Emergency procedure



Suitable extinguishing media

Carbon dioxide. Dry powder. Water spray jet. Fight larger fires with water spray jet or alcohol-resistant

Environmental precautions Methods for cleaning up

Do not allow to enter drainage system, surface or ground water. Dilute with plenty of water.

Absorb with liquid-binding material (sand, diatomite, universal binders, sawdust).

First aid measures



Inhalation:

Call a POISON CENTRE, doctor or physician if you feel unwell. Skin contact:

Wash skin with plenty of lukewarm, gently flowing water. Take off immediately all contaminated clothing and wash it before re-use. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice or attention.

Eye contact: Immediately rinse eyes cautiously with lukewarm water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If irritation occurs and persists, get medical attention. Rinse mouth. Immediately drink 1 glass of water. Get medical attention or advice if you feel unwell. Ingestion:
